

## How to Install the CA Certificate (iPhone & iPad)

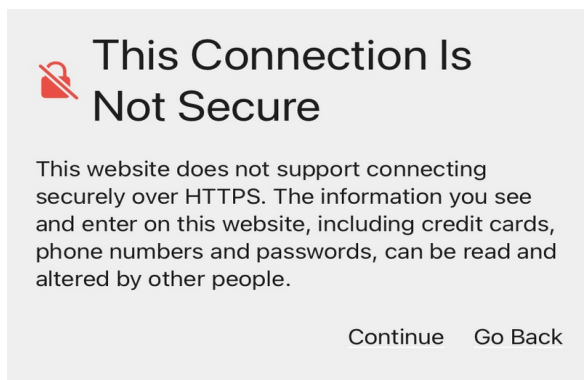
**Note:** Setting names may vary based on the IOS Version. (Instructions for iOS version 26.4.1)

Follow these steps to install and trust the **EDRootCA.cer** certificate on your iOS device to ensure a secure connection to the dashboard.

### 1. Accessing the Dashboard

Enter <https://<ip>:8444> in the search bar.

When you first attempt to open the dashboard, your browser will show a "This Connection Is Not Private" or "This Site is Not Secure" warning.



- Tap on **Show Details** or **Advanced** or **Go Back**.
- Tap the link at the bottom: "**Visit this website**".
- Confirm by tapping **Visit Website** on the pop-up.
- Once the page loads, locate the download link for the certificate in the info tab
- If the page does not load, tap the refresh icon in the browser once.

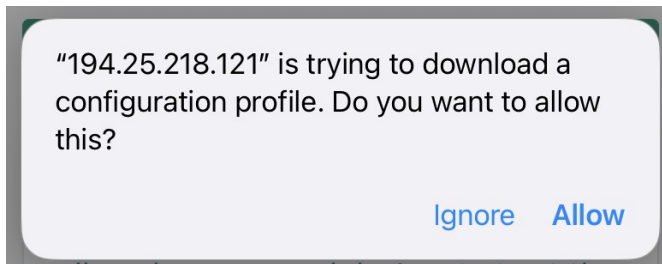
## 2. Download the Certificate in Safari

Open the download link using the **Safari** browser.

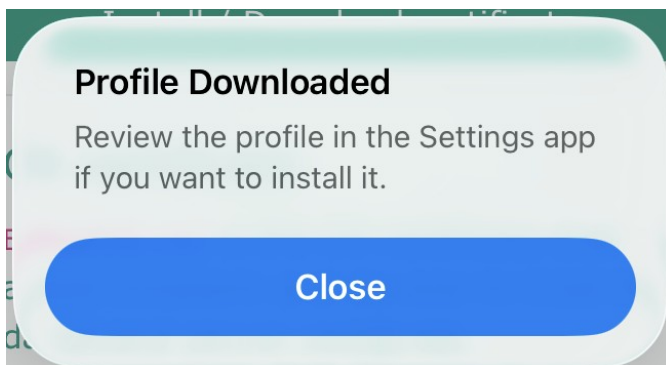
Tab into the Info category.

Press the install button to install the certificate.

When the prompt appears, tap **Allow** to download the configuration profile.



Confirmation message: "Profile Downloaded. Review the profile in the Settings app if you want to install it."

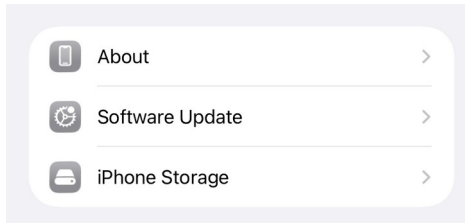


Tap **Close**.

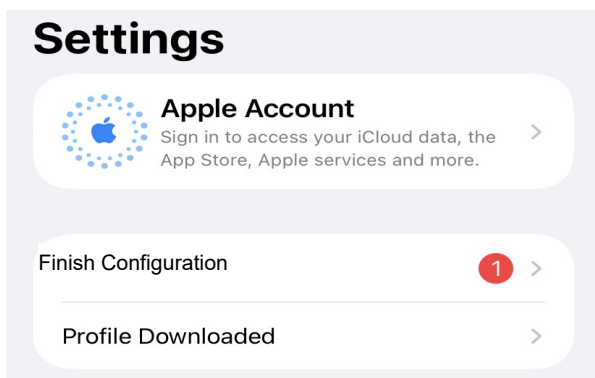
### 3. Open Settings to Install

Once downloaded, you must manually activate the profile in your system settings.

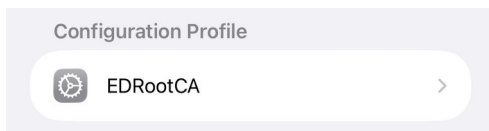
Open the **Settings** app.



Tap on **Profile Downloaded** (located just below your Apple ID).



Tap the "EDRootCA".

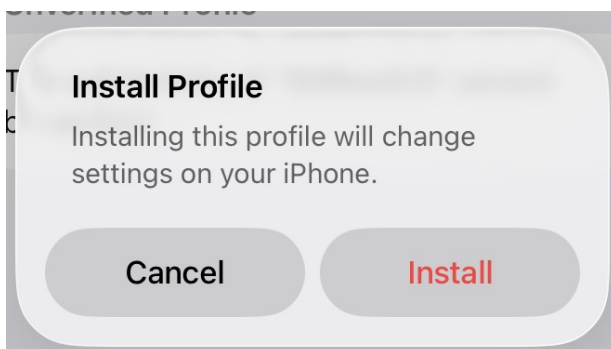


On the "Install Profile" screen, tap **Install** in the top right corner.

Enter your device **Passcode** when prompted.

Tap **Install** again on the "Warning" screen and the final confirmation pop-up.

Tap **Done**.

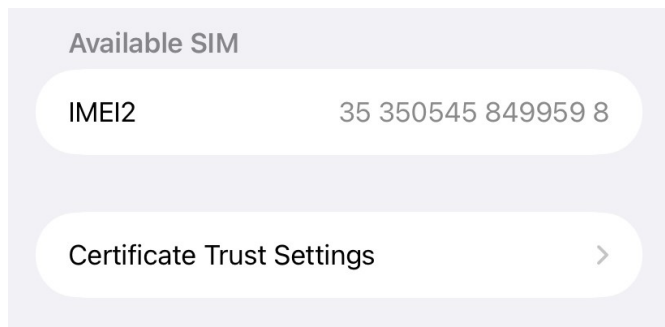


## 4. Enable Full Trust

Installing the profile is not enough; you must manually trust the root certificate to enable encryption for the dashboard.

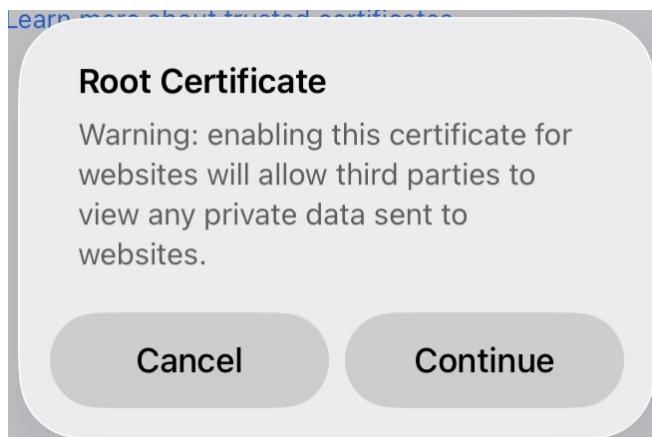
Go to **Settings > General > About**.

Scroll to the very bottom and tap **Certificate Trust Settings**.



Under "ENABLE FULL TRUST FOR ROOT CERTIFICATES," locate **EDRootCA**. Toggle the switch to **ON** (Green ●).

A warning will appear: "Trusting this certificate will allow third parties to inspect any data sent to websites." Tap **Continue**



## 5. Finalize

To ensure the settings take effect:

**Close Safari** completely (swipe up from the bottom of your screen to the multitasking view and swipe Safari away).

**Reopen Safari** and navigate back to the **Karl Mayer** dashboard.

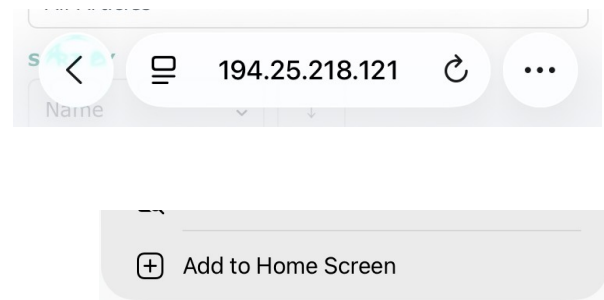
The "Not Secure" warning will disappear, and the connection will be encrypted.

**Note:** Only install certificates from organizations you trust. This certificate is required to verify the identity of the local server.

## 6. Add to Home (Safari)

Adding the page to your home screen:

- Open webpage on your phone/iPad
- Tap the three dots beside the search bar
- Press "Share", then "View more"
- Now press "Add to Home Screen"
- Enter the name you want to give this shortcut
- Finalize by tapping the Add button on the top right



The shortcut should now be added to your home screen.
